



## **AGREEMENT**

between

Pázmány Péter Catholic University, Hungary

and

Samara National Research University

(Samara University), Russian Federation

Pázmány Péter Catholic University and Samara University (hereinafter referred to as Parties) have come to the following agreement in order to elaborate and implement International Multidisciplinary Research and Development Project "The Early Magyars on the Volga River":

- Clause 1. Parties undertake to strongly encourage development of the scientific cooperation in keeping with friendly relations and mutual understanding.
- Clause 2. The Parties have agreed to cooperate in the form of elaboration and implementation of the International Multidisciplinary Research and Development Project "The Early Magyars on the Volga River".
- Clause 3. To ensure successful development of the specified research and development project the Parties contemplate:
- 3.1. Conduction of joint researches in the framework of the project in the field of archaeology and related disciplines within the Russian and Hungarian territories;
- Conduction of archaeological exhibitions, conferences and symposia in the framework of the project;
- 3.3. Publication of scientific papers collections dedicated to the project subject and of a final monographic edition;

3.4. Production of a popular science film on the project implementation.

Clause 4. To ensure successful implementation of International Multidisciplinary Research and Development Project "The Early Magyars on the Volga River", the Parties have agreed to create an International Russian-Hungarian Archaeological Expedition on the basis of Samara University to conduct scientific researches within the territory of the Russian Federation and on the basis of the Catholic University to conduct scientific researches within the territory of Hungary.

Clause 5. To implement the present Agreement, the Parties assign the following coleaders of the project:

5.1. On behalf of Pázmány Péter Catholic University:

Attila Türk, Associate Professor at the Institute of Archaeology of Pázmány Péter Catholic University Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences.

5.2. On behalf of Samara University:

Sergei Edgardovich Zubov, the head of the Archaeological Research and Development Laboratory.

Clause 6. The specified co-leaders should regularly conduct consultations to discuss the achieved results and advanced planning.

Clause 7. The Agreement is valid for five years. If one of the Parties decides to terminate the present Agreement, it should notify the other Party in writing at least six months in advance.

Clause 8. The Agreement comes into force upon signature by both parties.

Clause 9. The Agreement is drawn up in English in four originals having equal legal force.
